Welcome to Trailerfest So Cal! Here are the current plans...

THURSDAY

Check-in: 1:00 pm - When you arrive: Stop at the main office to receive/confirm your site. AFTER you have parked your trailer check in with the hosts in site #73. We have some goodies for you! The hosts will be available for check-in on Wednesday from 2-4 pm, Thursday from Noon-4 pm, Friday from 8 am-Noon, and Saturday from 10 am-2 pm. Please do not ask for your site number. You will receive it at check-in. Check-out on Sunday: 11:00 am

6:00 pm - Pot Luck Reception at the host site #73. (A NEW Location this year: Between sections E and F near the maintenance yard.) The park is large so if you are driving to the potluck or pancake breakfast on Thursday and Friday, you may park in the tent site parking area which is reserved for us. The parking area in front of the tent area is reserved for Saturday's carshow. No parking for us there on Saturday until after the car show. We will also have some shuttle service around the park. More details to come.

FRIDAY

7:30 am – 9 am Pancake Breakfast at the host site #73. You may park in the tent site parking area.

Toy Show and Shine/Swap Meet at your site. Set up your collection of tin toys, trailers, cars, Hot Wheels, etc. Display only or sell and swap as you like. Participation ribbons and trophies for the most creative.

Tiny Trailer Show: Build a trailer from scratch or use a vintage toaster, canned ham can, or anything else you can craft an old RV from. Maximum 18" long, 12" wide, and 12" tall. Participation ribbons and trophies for the most creative and the most realistic. PLEASE DISPLAY YOUR TRAILER AT THE HOST SITE (#73) ON SATURDAY FOR JUDGING. (Drop your entry off between 9 and 10 am and pick it up at 2 pm.)

6:30 pm-ish Music Jam Around the Campfire-Bring an instrument and join in or just come and listen. (Hosted by Paulette Rees-Denis in site #F86)

SATURDAY

8:00 am. Cars and Coffee and Donuts. Near the maintenance area

Pinewood Derby Races Races will be in the laundry parking lot. (Near the office and site A136.) Enter your car at 9am. Practice from 9am to Noon. The races are at noon. The derby will be hosted by a local Boy Scout Troop. See the official Boy Scout Rules. Participation ribbons and trophies for the fastest and most creative. We will have a few cars available at the rally for \$10.

10 am to 2 pm Open House and Classic Car Show. You may display your vintage tow vehicle, classic or hot rod at your campsite. If you would like to enter a car in the show and park in that area on Saturday, you must complete a form and enter with the park. Food Trucks, Vendors. Open to the public. Free admission. Visitors must park off-site.

7:00 pm Cash Killer and the King Band on the stage in the tent area. Parking in the tent area will be available for the band.
